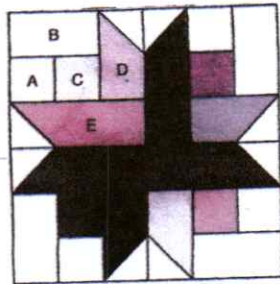


RE: BLOCK OF THE MONTH FOR OCTOBER

LOTTERY BLOCK



12" x 12" Finished Block

Materials:

- 2-1/2" x WOF of chosen colours.

Cutting:

- From precut strips, cut:

- 4 (2-1/2" x 6-1/2") E rectangles: brown, gold, red, green -
- 4 (2-1/2" x 4-1/2") D rectangles: brown, gold, red, green -
- 4 (2-1/2") C squares: orange, brown, gold ,
- 4 (2-1/2" x 4-1/2") B rectangles: grey or beige background colour
- 12 (2-1/2") A squares: grey or beige background colour

Completing the Block:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of one A square. Repeat for a total of 8A squares.
2. Lay one marked square on one assorted D rectangle (see Figure 1).
3. Stitch on the marked line, trim seam allowance to  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press open. Make 4 A-D units.

4. In the same way, use the remaining marked A squares and assorted E rectangles to make A-E units (see Figure 2). Make 4.

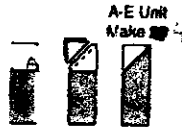

5. Sew one A square to one C square (Figure 3a) and sew one B rectangle to the top edge (Figure 3b). Press. Make 4 A-B-C units.

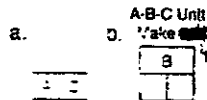

6. Sew one A-D unit to the right side of one A-B-C unit (Figure 4). Press.
7. Sew one A-E unit to the bottom to make a quarter-block unit. Make 4 quarter-block units.

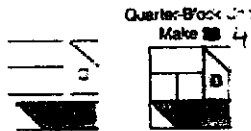

8. Lay out four quarter-block units into 2 rows of 2 units (Figure 5). Sew into rows and join the rows to complete the block.

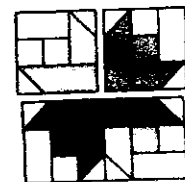
