CATGEGORIES - "CELEBRATE CANADA 150' QUILT SHOW 2017

HAND QUILTED – Quilt top and quilting must be completed by the same person:

1. Hand Quilted Quilt 300 inches and over in perimeter ALL WORK MUST BE YOUR OWN

2. Hand Quilted Quilt less than 300 inches in perimeter ALL WORK MUST BE YOUR OWN

3. Hand Quilted Wall Hanging – any size ALL WORK MUST BE YOUR OWN

MACHINE QUILTED – Quilt top and quilting must be completed by the same person quilting done on a domestic sewing machine

- not a sit-down mid-arm, mid arm or long-arm machine - see Categories 10-16

4. Machine Quilted Quilt 300 inches and over in perimeter ALL WORK MUST BE YOUR OWN

5. Machine Quilted Quilt less than 300 inches in perimeter ALL WORK MUST BE YOUR OWN

6. Machine Quilted Wall Hanging – any size ALL WORK MUST BE YOUR OWN

HAND APPLIQUE

7. Hand Appliqué Any Size 72' INCHES IN PERIMETER AND OVER

MACHINE APPLIQUE

8. Machine Appliqué Quilt greater than 200 inches in perimeter

9. Machine Appliqué Wall Hanging – any size

MID OR LONG ARM QUILTED - Quilt was quilted on a Mid Arm, Sit-down Mid Arm or Long Arm Machine

- 10. Mid or Long Arm quilted Quilt 300 inches and over in perimeter, QUILTING DONE BY SOMEONE OTHER THAN YOURSELF (QUILTER TO BE IDENTIFIED)
- 11. Mid or Long Arm Quilted Quilt less than 300 inches and more than 200 inches, QUILTING DONE BY SOMEONE OTHER THAN YOURSELF (QUILTER TO BE IDENTIFIED)
- 12. Mid or Long Arm Quilted Under 200 inches in perimeter, QUILTING DONE BY SOMEONE OTHER THAN YOURSELF (QUILTER TO BE IDENTIFIED)
- 13. Mid or Long Arm Quilted Quilt 300 inches and over in perimeter QUILTING IS YOUR OWN WORK
- 14. Mid or Long Arm Quilted Quilt less than 300 inches and more than 200 inches in perimeter QUILTING IS YOUR OWN WORK
- 15. Mid or Long Arm Quilted Quilt under 200 inches in perimeter QUILTING IS YOUR OWN WORK
- 16. CUSTOM QUILTED MID OR LONG ARM Any Size QUILTER TO BE IDENTIFIED

ART QUILTS

- 17. **Art Quilt** Quilt over 100 inches, must be an original design and must include two or more dominant techniques including but not limited to appliqué, piecing, embroidery, dyeing, embellishment, painting, machine quilting and hand quilting. Must not be the finished project of a workshop or class. **ALL WORK MUST BE YOUR OWN.**
- 18. **Art Quilt** Quilt under 100 inches, must be an original design and must include two or more dominant techniques including but not limited to appliqué, piecing, embroidery, dyeing, embellishment, painting, machine quilting and hand quilting. Must not be the finished project of a workshop or class. **ALL WORK MUST BE YOUR OWN.**

- 19. **Youth Quilt** High School Age Student only with minimal adult help any size, any technique. Any adult help must be stated; who helped and what did the adult do. This will be a judged category with first, second and honourable participant awarded.
- 20. **Youth Quilt** Elementary School Age Student only with minimal adult help any size, and technique. Any adult help must be stated; who helped and what did the adult do. This will be a judged category with first, second and honourable participant awarded.
- 21. **3D OBJECT** Any quilted item that is NOT a quilt, wall hanging, table runner, place mat, tree skirt, bag or purse (ie: fabric box, sculpture, doll, wearable or accessory that isn't a bag/purse) any size and technique. Must have visible quilting on a minimum of 50% of the object. **ALL WORK MUST BE YOUR OWN**
- 22. **Beginner Quilt** any size, any technique, may be part of a beginner or a learn-to-quilt workshop or class. Must have started quilting within the last 5 years. **ALL WORK MUST BE YOUR OWN**.
- 23. **Senior Quilt** any size. Any technique; must be made by a quilter 75 years or older; must have been made within the past three years and not been shown in any Moose Jaw Prairie Hearts Quilt Show.
- 24. **Friendship or Group Quilt** Hand Quilted any size; work on this quilt is that of more than two people (i.e. Block exchange, round robin, group exchange, etc); names of all who contributed to the quilt should be on the label.
- 25. **Friendship or Group Quilt** Machine Quilted any size; work on this quilt is that of more than two people (i.e. Block exchange, round robin, group exchange, etc.); names of all who contributed to the quilt should be on the label.
- 26. Scrap Quilts any size, any technique and must contain a large variety of scrap fabrics.
- 27. **Varied Techniques** any size, includes but not limited to hand piecing, English paper piecing, crazy quilts, hand embroidery, Battenburg lace, thread painting, machine embroidery etc.
- 28. **Modern Quilts** Any size, must include, but not limited to the use of bold colours and prints, high contrast and graphic areas of solid colour, improvisational piecing, minimalism, expansive negative space, and alternate grid work. **ALL WORK MUST BE YOUR OWN**.
- 29. **Modern Quilts** Any size, must include, but not limited to the use of bold colours and prints, high contrast and graphic areas of solid colour, improvisational piecing, minimalism, expansive negative space, and alternate grid work.
- **30. Quilted Bags** Must have visible quilting on at least 50% of the bag.
- 31. Recycled Materials Quilt any size; no garments; 50% of the fabrics must come from a recycle source (old bedspreads, ties, coats, draperies, etc) please indicate the recycled materials.
- **32. Traditional Miniature Quilts** less than 72 inches perimeter MUST BE based on a traditional design may be pieced or appliquéd.
- 33. Paper Pieced Quilt any size; the majority if the quilt must have used paper piecing technique.
- 34. Table Runners or Placemats or Tree Skirts only Any size, any technique
- **35. Row by Row Quilt** Any size, must have distinct row pattern and contain at least one "Row by Row" pattern from a participating quilt shop.

SPECIAL AWARD QUILT (SAQ) - THEME IS "OH! CANADA, EH?!"

Limited to one entry per person. ALL WORK MUST BE YOUR OWN.

Quilt must be less than 200 inches in perimeter and use red & white fabrics along with any other colours you want to use.

With the theme in mind your piece will be a quilted representation of your vision of what it means to be Canadian. Humour is encouraged but not required.

GUILD CHALLENGE (GC) – THEME IS "WITH GLOWING HEARTS"

Limited to one entry per person. ALL WORK MUST BE YOUR OWN.

Quilt must be less than 300" in perimeter and use red and white fabrics along with any other colours you want to use. Quilt must contain the following two components:

Component 1 It must be a quilted representation of your pride in Canada.

Component 2 It must include a short written explanation (300 words or less) of your inspiration and may include a photo.

Quilt Show Rules

- 1. Any entry must have been completed within the last two years with the exception of Category 22, which must have been completed within the past five years and Category 23, which must have been completed within the past three years. All entries must not have been previously shown in any Moose Jaw Prairie Hearts Quilt Show.
- 2. Quilted items must have at least 3 distinct layers and must have some quilting visible on each side with the exception of Category 21 which must have quilting visible on at least one side. Framed entries will not be accepted into the show.
- 3. <u>All work must be your own</u> in Categories 1,2,3,4,5,6,13,14,15,17,18,22,28,Special Awards Quilt (SAQ) and Guild Challenge (GC). These Categories are clearly marked that all work must be your own.
- 4. In all categories you must state who it is pieced by, quilted by, and the origin of the pattern if known. (Eg: The name of the book and author, or magazine name, and issue it came from.)
- 5. Only one entry per category is allowed. Special Awards Quilt (SAQ) and Guild Challenge (GC) are limited to one entry per person. Items deemed inappropriate for one category may be reassigned into an appropriate category.
- 6. **There is a \$15.00 entry fee for non-guild members**. This fee covers all of your entries. Please make cheques payable to: Moose Jaw Prairie Hearts Quilt Show.
- 7. Hanging sleeves are **preferred** on all quilts that are less than 36 inches in height. For any quilts that are longer than 36 inches in width and less than 36 inches in height, we ask that you put a split sleeve on the quilt, rather than one continuous sleeve. Hanging sleeves must be at least 2 inches wide.
- 8. Judging will be done by a qualified judge and entrants will receive a written evaluation. This evaluation and any prize money may be picked up at the administration table on April 28 or April 29 between 1:00pm -2:30pm. If the evaluation is not picked up it will be given to you during quilt pick-up on April 29 between 5:00pm and 6:00pm.
- 9. Should there be less than three entries in a category, the judge reserves the right to award less than 1st place.
- 10. A label must be sewn on the back of the quilt and must include the quilt maker's name.
- 11. Entries must be in a Ikea blue bag or similar carry bag, clearly marked with the name of the entrant. No cloth bags, pillow cases, tubes, boxes or display boards will be accepted. Please use safety pins for attaching entry tags. NO STRAIGHT PINS.
- 12. An entry form is included with this pamphlet. Use a separate entry form for each entry. Make copies as needed.
- 13. Please be sure you fill out the correct sizes for your quilts and wall hangings. Entry forms and fees must be received by March 16, 2017. Please drop off or mail to:

- 14. Fill out all three portions of the entry tag and submit with your quilt. You will receive your entry number(s) before the quilt drop off date. One tag will go on your quilt, one will go on to the bag and one will be returned to you as a receipt.
- 15. Quilt show entries that are mailed, couriered and delivered by bus are due by April 8, 2017. These entries are mailed to Flo Blair at the address above.
- 16. All entries must be delivered to the Quilt Show Committee between 9:00am -5:00pm on April 8 and April 9, 2017. Entries that are mailed, couriered and delivered by bus are exempt from this window. Entry drop off location is:

17. Entries must be picked up at the Moose Jaw Exhibition Convention Centre on Saturday, April 29, 2017 between 5:00pm and 6:00pm unless you have prepaid for return shipping. You will require your entry tag receipt for pickup. If you are unable to pick up your own quilt(s) please notify us as to who is picking up your quilt(s) in advance. Please be patient as we have a short window of time and many quilts to return.
