



Everything Old is New Again

Categories – “Everything Old is New Again” Quilt Show 2019

1. *Hand Quilted* – Greater than 300” perimeter, quilt top and quilting must be completed by the same person.
2. *Hand Quilted* – Less than 300” perimeter, quilt top and quilting must be completed by the same person.
3. *Machine Quilted* – Greater than 300” perimeter, domestic machine only, quilt top and quilting must be completed by the same person.
4. *Machine Quilted* – Less than 300” perimeter, domestic machine only, quilt top and quilting must be completed by the same person.
5. *Appliqué* – Greater than 200” perimeter, may be hand or machine appliqué, quilt top must be completed by the same person.
6. *Appliqué* – Less than 200” perimeter, may be hand or machine appliqué, quilt top must be completed by the same person.
7. *Mid or Long Arm Quilted* – Over 300” perimeter. **QUILTING DONE BY SOMEONE OTHER THAN YOU, QUILTER MUST BE IDENTIFIED.**
8. *Mid or Long Arm Quilted* – Under 300” perimeter. **QUILTING DONE BY SOMEONE OTHER THAN YOU, QUILTER MUST BE IDENTIFIED.**
9. *Mid or Long Arm Quilted* – Over 300” perimeter. **QUILT TOP AND QUILTING MUST BE COMPLETED BY THE SAME PERSON.**
10. *Mid or Long Arm Quilted* – Under 300” perimeter. **QUILT TOP AND QUILTING MUST BE COMPLETED BY THE SAME PERSON.**
11. *Custom Quilted Mid or Long Arm* – Any Size - **QUILTING DONE BY SOMEONE OTHER THAN YOU, QUILTER MUST BE IDENTIFIED.**
12. *Art Quilt* – Must be an original design and composition and may be abstract (non-pictorial, with emphasis on colour, line and design), portrait (must illustrate some recognizable aspect of the human or animal form), or landscape/still life (must illustrate aspects of natural or manmade scenery or recognizable object), all work must be your own.
13. *New Generation* – Under 16 years of age; any size; any technique; can be quilted on a domestic, sit down or stand up mid/long arm machine by the person who made the quilt with **minimal** adult help.
14. *Beginner* – Any size; any technique; may be part of a beginner or learn to quilt workshop or class. Must have started quilting within the last 5 years. **ALL WORK MUST BE YOUR OWN.**
15. *Senior Quilt* – Any size; any technique; must be made by a quilter 75 years or older; must have been made within the past three years and not been shown in any Moose Jaw Prairie Hearts Quilt Show.
16. *Friendship or Group Quilt* – Hand Quilted – any size; work on this quilt is that of more than two people (i.e. block exchange, round robin, group exchange, etc.); names of all who contributed to the quilt should be on the label.
17. *Friendship or Group Quilt* – Machine Quilted – any size; work on this quilt is that of more than two people (i.e. block exchange, round robin, group exchange, etc.); names of all who contributed to the quilt should be on the label.
18. *Scrap Quilts* – any size; any technique and must contain a large variety of scrap fabrics.

19. *Varied Techniques* – any size; includes but not limited to: hand piecing, English paper piecing, crazy quilts, hand embroidery, Battenburg lace, thread painting, machine embroidery, etc. **NO 3-D OBJECTS OR CLOTHING.**
20. *Modern Quilts* – Any size; must include but not limited to: the use of bold colours and prints, high contrast and graphic areas of solid colour, improvisational piecing, minimalism, expansive negative space and alternate grid work.
21. *Recycled Materials Quilt* – Any size; **no garments or 3-D objects**; 50% of the fabrics must come from a recycle source (i.e. bedspreads, ties, coats, draperies, etc.), please indicate the recycle source.
22. *Miniature Quilt* – less than 96” perimeter, may be pieced (if pieced maximum 4” block size) or appliquéd, **MUST BE** based on a traditional design.
23. *Paper Pieced Quilt* – Any size; the majority of the quilt must have used a paper piecing technique.
24. *Table Runner/Bed Runner* – Any size; any technique.
25. *Row by Row Quilt* – Any size; must have a distinct row pattern.

Special Award Quilt (SAQ) – Theme is 'Everything Old is New Again'

- Limited to one entry per person

- ALL WORK MUST BE YOUR OWN

- Quilt must be less than 300 inches in perimeter and larger than 100 inches in perimeter

- Must use block or blocks that are in the public domain and re-interpret those blocks to make a uniquely new design. Everything prior to 1923 is in the public domain. There was no copyright law. Next, anything from 1923 to 1963 for which copyright was not renewed. If you have a block in mind check it out at: www.quiltindex.org to find out if it fits the criteria.

Guild Challenge (GC) – Theme is 'Everything Old is New Again'

- Guild members only

- Limited to one entry per person

- ALL WORK MUST BE YOUR OWN

- Present a block no larger than 12 ½” x 12 ½” finished size (This will accommodate adding an edge treatment without cutting off any points from a 12” finished block.) – must be quilted, bound and have a hanging sleeve

- Block must be a quilted representation of an old block updated to make it new and fresh.

- To make an old block new and fresh includes but is not limited to updating colour palette, adding/subtracting seams, curving seams, making a hybrid block from 2 blocks, etc.

- Please include the name of the original block you are updating in your write-up. You may also attach a line drawing of the original block to the entry for clarification purposes.

2019 Quilt Show Rules

1. Any entry must have been completed within the last two years with the exception of Category 14, which must have been completed within the past five years and Category 15, which must have been completed within the past three years. All entries must not have been previously shown in any Moose Jaw Prairie Hearts Quilt Show.
2. Quilted items must have at least 3 distinct layers and must have some quilting visible on each side. Framed entries will not be accepted into the show.
3. **All work must be your own** in Categories 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 9, 10, 12, 13, 14, Special Awards Quilt (SAQ) and Guild Challenge (GC). These Categories are clearly marked that all work must be your own.
4. In all categories you must state who it is pieced by, quilted by, and the origin of the pattern if known. (Eg: The name of the book and author, or magazine name, and issue it came from.)
5. Only one entry per person per category is allowed. Special Awards Quilt (SAQ) and Guild Challenge (GC) are limited to one entry per person. Items deemed inappropriate for one category may be reassigned into an appropriate category.
6. **There is a \$15.00 entry fee for non-guild members.** This fee covers all of your entries. Please make cheques payable to: Moose Jaw Prairie Hearts Quilters' Guild Inc.
7. Hanging sleeves are **preferred** on all quilts that are less than 36 inches in height. For any quilts that are longer than 36 inches in width and less than 36 inches in height, we ask that you put a split sleeve on the quilt, rather than one continuous sleeve. Hanging sleeves must be at least 2 inches wide.
8. Judging will be done by a qualified judge and entrants will receive a written evaluation. This evaluation and any prize money may be picked up at the administration table on May 3 or May 4 between 1:00pm -2:30pm. If the evaluation is not picked up it will be given to you during quilt pick-up on May 4 between 5:00pm and 6:00pm.
9. Should there be less than three entries in a category, the judge reserves the right to award less than 1st place.
10. A label must be sewn on the back of the quilt and must include the quilt maker's name.
11. Entries must be in an Ikea blue bag or similar carry bag, clearly marked with the name of the entrant. No cloth bags, pillow cases, tubes, boxes or display boards will be accepted. Please use safety pins for attaching entry tags. **NO STRAIGHT PINS.**
12. An entry form is included with this pamphlet. **Use a separate entry form for each entry. Make copies as needed.**
13. Please be sure you fill out the correct sizes for your quilts and wall hangings. Entry forms and fees must be received by Thursday, March 21, 2019. Please drop off, mail or email to:

Please use the category number and your last name.first name for the file name. (example: 12. Smith.Sue, 15. Smith.Sue, SAQ. Smith.Sue)
14. Fill out all three portions of the entry tag and submit with your quilt. You will receive your entry number(s) before the quilt drop off date. One tag will go on your quilt, one will go on to the bag and one will be returned to you as a receipt.
15. Quilt show entries that are mailed or couriered are due by Friday, April 12, 2019. These entries are mailed to Roberta Arens at the address below.
16. All entries must be delivered to the Quilt Show Committee between 9:00am -5:00pm on Saturday, April 27 and Sunday, April 28, 2019. Entries that are mailed, couriered and delivered by bus are exempt from this window. Entry drop off location is:

17. Entries must be picked up at the Moose Jaw Exhibition Convention Centre on Saturday, May 4, 2019 between **5:00pm and 6:00pm** unless you have prepaid for return shipping. You will require your entry tag receipt for pickup. If you are unable to pick up your own quilt(s) please notify us as to who is picking up your quilt(s) in advance. **Please be patient** as we have a short window of time and many quilts to return.
